

ICC T20 WORLD CUP 2020 SCHOOLS TICKETING PROGRAM AUSTRALIA

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Program is offered by T20 World Cup 2020 Ltd (T20WC 2020) and is open to schools in Australia who register for the Program. To apply to the Program, schools must submit a completed Schools Ticket Booking Form (Booking Form) and comply with these terms and conditions. Only principals or teachers affiliated with a school may submit a Booking Form.
2. Tickets are strictly limited per venue and subject to availability. Tickets are only available for the matches specified in the Booking Form. Schools may only select one match from within their State. Tickets will be allocated to schools registered with the Program on a first in first served basis.
3. Successful schools will be allocated tickets for the T20WC 2020 match specified in the Booking Form. Thirty (30) tickets will be allocated to successful schools on a first in first serve basis, comprising of up to twenty-five (25) Child tickets and five (5) Adult tickets per school for students and support staff (including parents). Schools are not guaranteed tickets to any match.
4. Schools wishing to purchase additional Child and/or Adults tickets will be able to indicate their preference on the provided Booking Form that will be sent from schools@t20worldcup.com.au from 01 October 2019. Any requests for additional tickets will need to be submitted on the Schools Ticketing Booking Form before 01 November 2019. Requests for additional tickets will be determined by T20WC 2020 at its discretion taking into account the amount requested, ticket availability and demand from registered schools. Any additional ticket purchases following 01 November 2019 will be subject to availability and must be made via tickets.t20worldcup.com. Tickets purchased after this time will not be purchased next to the pre ordered tickets.
5. Schools should carefully consider student to supervisor ratios and will be required to nominate the number of students and supervisors for whom tickets are requested above the 30 complimentary tickets. Schools will be responsible for supervising their students at the match. Additional tickets will be allocated at a maximum ratio of 6 children to 1 supervisor.
6. Successful schools will be notified by email by the T20WC 2020 Ticketing Team from 13 November 2019. In the event that the allocation of tickets is exhausted for a relevant match, the details of your school will be recorded and you will be contacted if additional tickets become available.

7. The use of any tickets is subject to the ICC T20 World Cup Australia 2020 **Ticket Terms and Conditions** and the relevant Venue Regulations. Venue Regulations will be available closer to the match. Schools should read and understand these in advance of attending the match, including to ensure that all students and supervisors know what can and cannot be brought into the venue.
8. The ICC T20 World Cup 2020 Refund Policy does not apply to these tickets and the registered school will not be entitled to any refund or transfer of tickets in the event that the match to which it has been allocated tickets is affected by rain or cancelled.
9. All costs, charges and expenses, including, without limitation, transportation, accommodation, food and beverages expenses, are the responsibility of the registered school, student and/or supervisor.
10. Tickets are non-transferable and are not redeemable for cash. Any attempt to sell or auction any allocated tickets or use the tickets for commercial or promotional purposes (including any school auction or other promotion) will result in cancellation of the tickets.
11. By providing your details (including contact details), you agree that you have read and accept the terms and conditions of the ICC T20 World Cup 2020 **Privacy Policy** and agree that your information may be used for the purposes set out in that policy. If you do not provide all details requested in the Booking Form, it may not be possible to allocate tickets to your school.
12. In accordance with applicable privacy law, personal information will be held to notify successful registered schools. You may access and request correction of your personal information by contacting the ICC T20 World Cup 2020 Privacy Officer at privacy@worldt20.com.au.
13. T20WC 2020 may at its discretion remove or cancel any registration they believe to be in breach of these terms and conditions or fraudulent in any way, and may cancel any tickets they believe to have been requested for persons not associated with the school specified in the Booking Form.
14. Registering to the Program does not constitute a ticket booking in any way, but rather a registration of interest. All ticket allocations are subject availability in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
